Check the pressure in your tires; then leave the car at home, and walk or bike one place you drove to last Tuesday.

FACTS

Fuel consumption rises 2.5% for every 10 lbs/sq inch that a tire is underinflated.

Cars and trucks account for 25% of carbon dioxide emissions. [ii]
