CHALLENGE

Celebrate "Earth Hour" on 3/26 from 8:30–9:30 p.m. by turning all lights off.

FACTS

Residential energy use produces 20% of national greenhouse gas emissions. Of that, 69% of residential emissions are the result of electricity use. [iil]

75% of the energy used to power household electronics is consumed when they are switched off. Using "smart power strips" eliminates phantom loads by shutting off the power to electronics when they are not in use. [iv]

LEARNING

What is the next best thing to installing solar panels on your house? It's a new program called "community solar" which allows you to replace electricity generated by fossil fuels with electricity created by solar farms in Illinois.

Last year, Kenilworth Union Church became one of the first houses of worship on the North Shore to participate in a community solar program. Already, the church is offsetting about 50,000 kWh (kilowatt hours) of electric power each year with energy generated from the sun.
